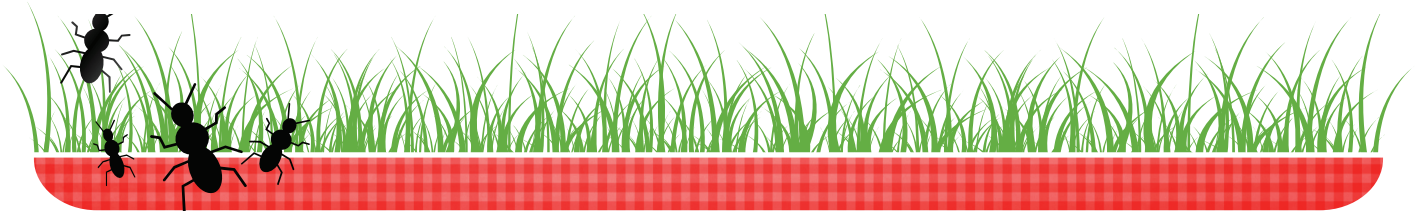


## HCMHomecoming2017 Personal Participation Ideas
